Supervisor Jenniffer Mullen stated *“Right now we are \$28,639 under cap. Kenny came in with a new sales quote of \$81,000 for his truck, quote was \$71,000. The offer for the old truck bed would cost more to put on the new truck. What I’d like to do, we put in quite a bit into the reserve for the town renovations, a lot of that we can even pull from another reserve if we choose to finish the building. So if anyone would not be opposed to changing that \$30,000 to \$20,000 and moving that \$10,000 to Kennys truck, that way we don’t have to, we’re not increasing, we’re just shuffling the money. The only other change is Ciara’s hours, keeping her at 22, that is in there now. She corrected me this morning. I now have this on the summary page, so that is fixed. And then finally, I just got off the phone with Wendy Jordan with property tax. She had asked me about Schoonover, how we want to bill. Estimated cost per user is \$437.08, now on the serial bonds, the number Jeff gave is without all of the maintenance. I have sent them an email to clarify, to make sure it wasn’t to be added to the users. So long story short, SW9 has been added with the tentative cost of \$37.08, unless Jeff tells me that we need to add the maintenance cost. Then I would need permission to adjust. Other than that nothing else has changed.”*
